- I need someone to help me to learn new parenting strategies and skills.
- I suddenly became a carer and I need support to access services.

What do we do?

The role of the case manager is to undertake assessment, monitoring, planning, advocacy and linking you with the services that you need.

- Case Coordination
- Home Visiting
- Referrals to other organisations
- Advocate on your behalf to appropriate agencies
- Increase knowledge on physical and emotional development of child/self
- Supportive network during difficult times
- Assistance in obtaining information on health and community service
- Linking in with services in your local community

In this program we welcome all families to share their experiences with parenting, we assess their goals and needs, then allocate a mentor to help carers build skills and engage with their family in a supportive way.
